

Mallard/Sweatt Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of two beloved and dedicated members of Hibben United Methodist Church.

For Hibben members only, the scholarship is to help supplement the financial needs of today's students. It is to be awarded on an academic year basis. A student is eligible to receive only one scholarship during any one academic year and must re-apply for each academic year.

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be sent to the church office no later than **12 o'clock pm May 2nd (no exceptions)**. The application must be in letter style (see Item 4).

Eligibility

An applicant must be:

1. An active, full member of Hibben United Methodist Church for at least one full year prior to date of application.
2. A student maintaining a grade average of C or better during the year prior to the award and **be able to supply support for grade average**.
3. Admitted to a degree program in an accepted college/university and **supply the scholarship committee with an acceptance letter**.
4. Able to supply the scholarship committee with an introductory letter (considered application) providing information about the applicant. **Please provide applicant's full name, address and phone number**, college/university attending, future goals and also describe activities the applicant has participated in at Hibben United Methodist Church.
5. At least 17 years of age
6. May be single or married

Recipient of this year's scholarship will be announced on Sunday, May 15th during the 10:30 worship service.

The amount the student receives will be determined by the funds available at the time the applications are received. Funding for this scholarship will be provided through gifts of Hibben members, church offerings, fundraisers and other designated gifts.
